September 13-16, 2008, Košice, Slovakia

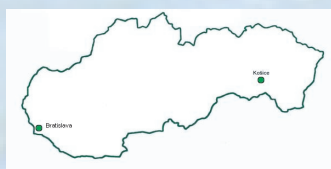
